## Legislation Text

Joint resolution authorizing a contract with CallOne Communications, Chicago, IL, for network communication services for the Emergency Telephone Safety Board (ETSB) in the estimated annual amount of \$61,800.

- Lake County desires to enter into a contract for network communication services for ETSB.
- Lake County extended requests to 90 potential vendors and five proposals were received.
- The ETSB Technology Committee evaluated all proposals.
- CallOne Communications is recommended as the firm that best meets the needs of the County based on RFP evaluation criteria.
- The contract authorizes a two year agreement with three additional one year renewal options and will cost ETSB an estimated annual amount of \$ 61,800 and a two year total of \$123,600.

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 5-102 of the Lake County Purchasing Ordinance, proposals were called for by publication for Network Communication Services for ETSB; and

WHEREAS, these services include MPLS circuits service connections for Lake County; and

**WHEREAS,** subsequent to said publication, Request for Proposals were extended to 90 vendors; and

**WHEREAS,** sealed proposals were received from five vendors and opened in the County Building, Waukegan, Illinois, on August 11, 2011 at 2:00 p.m.; and

**WHEREAS,** based on the criteria set forth in the Request for Proposals, the ETSB Technology Committee evaluated all proposals and determined that the proposal submitted by CallOne, Chicago, IL is the most favorable proposal for Lake County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that the Purchasing Agent is authorized to enter into and negotiate a two year contract with three additional one year renewal options with CallOne, Chicago, IL, for Network Communication Services in the estimated annual amount of \$61,800 and a two year total of \$123,600.
