Joint resolution authorizing the Lake County Workforce Development Department to enter into an Incumbent Worker Training Agreement in the amount of \$17,100 with Vapor Bus International.

- The Lake County Workforce Investment Board approved an incumbent worker program that calls for the transfer of up to 10% of its dislocated worker formula allocation to support necessary training.
- The agreement will be with Vapor Bus International, a company located in Buffalo Grove that provides automatic door systems for the public transit industry.
- Two employees will receive Computerized Numerically Controlled equipment training in set-up, operating and programming.
- The cost of training is \$15,390 (Workforce Development) plus \$1,700 (employer) for a total cost of \$17,100. The cost per employee is \$8,550.

### RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, and the Lake County Workforce Investment Board has approved a five-year plan that allows ten percent of the Workforce Investment Act formula funds for dislocated workers to be used for Incumbent Worker Training as a layoff aversion strategy; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lake County Workforce Development Department wishes to enter into an agreement with Vapor Bus International for the purpose of conducting incumbent worker training for 2 Vapor Bus International employees; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that the Lake County Workforce Development Department is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with Vapor Bus International in the amount of \$15,390 for the purpose of training 2 incumbent workers charging the costs thereof to account #750-4042040-79940-000-000-000-Y2010.
