Joint resolution appropriating \$50,000 of Motor Fuel Tax funds for concrete pavement patching, where necessary, on various County highways and designated as Section 12-00000-08-GM.

- 2012 Concrete Pavement Patching: Appropriation.
- Each year, the County undertakes patching of its concrete pavements to preserve surface quality, including repairing damaged manholes, catch basins, curbs, and gutters.
- This patching and repair is done on isolated sections of pavements that are not listed in the Five-Year Program for resurfacings/rehabilitation/reconstruction, but identified by the Pavement Management System as needing repair.
- Before a letting can be held, an appropriation of \$50,000 of Motor Fuel Tax funds is necessary.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in order to preserve pavement condition of the concrete pavements throughout the County highway system, each year the Division of Transportation undertakes the concrete pavement patching, where necessary, on various County highways; and

WHEREAS, the annual survey of pavement conditions has been completed.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by this Lake County Board, that there is hereby appropriated \$50,000 of Motor Fuel Tax funds to provide for the 2012 concrete pavement patching, where necessary, on various County highways; including repairing damaged manholes, catch basins, curbs, and gutters, and designated as Section 12-00000-08-GM.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this appropriation be processed by the County Engineer for final approval of the Illinois Department of Transportation in accordance with the "Agreement of Understanding" between the Illinois Department of Transportation and Lake County, dated January 22, 2003.
