## Legislation Text

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Joint resolution authorizing a contract with Evoqua Water Technologies, Sarasota, Florida, for Calcium Nitrate and related accessories/services in the amount of \$118,080.

- There is a need for the supply of calcium nitrate (used for odor control), a storage and delivery system, as well as monitoring and testing of the chemical for the Quentin Road Pump Station.
- Sealed bids were received from four vendors, and upon review it was determined that two of the bids were no-bids, and the apparent low bidder was determined to be non-responsive by Lake County Purchasing.
- Evoqua Water Technologies was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder who best meets the needs of the County for an estimated annual cost of \$118,080.

### RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, there is a need for the supply of calcium nitrate (used for odor control), a storage and delivery system, as well as monitoring and testing of the chemical for the Quentin Road Pump Station; and

**WHEREAS**, sealed bids were received from four vendors on January 19, 2021 at 11:00 a.m; and

**WHEREAS**, upon review two of the submitted bids were no-bids and Lake County Purchasing deemed the apparent low bidder non-responsive; and

**WHEREAS**, based on the criteria set forth in the Invitation to Bid; staff evaluated the bid submittals and determined that the bid submitted by Evoqua Water Technologies, Sarasota, Florida, in the estimated annual amount \$118,080, is the only responsive and responsible bidder that meets the needs of the County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that the Purchasing Agent is authorized to enter into a contract with Evoqua Water Technologies, for the Calcium Nitrate for Public Works in the estimated annual amount of \$118,080.
