Joint resolution authorizing an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$45,000 in funding from the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services and the approval of Grant Agreement No. 2012-55-024-K4D for the 19<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit's Access and Visitation Program for state fiscal year 2013.

- The 19<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit receives grant funding from the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services to provide mediation services for never-married parents involved in visitation and custody-related disputes in an effort to increase child support collections from this population.
- The state would like to continue funding the 19<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit's program in the amount of \$45,000 for state fiscal year 2013.
- This access and visitation grant does not require matching funds.
- Last year, this program served 222 families.

**WHEREAS**, the 19<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit entered into an agreement in state fiscal year 2009 with the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services to provide mediation services for non-married parents involved in visitation and custody-related disputes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services would like to continue funding the 19<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit's program in the amount of \$45,000 for state fiscal year 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, this access and visitation grant does not require matching funds; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to approve the new intergovernmental agreement and appropriate the \$45,000 in funding to formally accept this grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that it hereby approves Agreement No. 2012-55-024-K4D with the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services and an emergency appropriation of \$45,000 for the 19<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit's Access and Visitation Program for state fiscal year 2013; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the \$45,000 be appropriated in account 101-3200010-71140-000-000-000-32002 with offsetting revenue to be deposited in account 101-3200010-45340-000-000-000-32002.
