Joint resolution authorizing the execution of an agreement with the State of Illinois/Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) for the obligation of \$262,562 in federal highway funds allocated to Lake County for the improvement at the intersection of Cedar Lake Road at Monaville Road and designated as Section 12-00153-09-MS.

- Cedar Lake Road at Monaville Road: IDOT Agreement.
- The County has been allocated federal funds for work on Cedar Lake Road and Monaville Road, and IDOT administers all federal highway funds.
- This agreement provides for the County to receive up to 80 percent reimbursement for the costs of relocating a Nicor gas main, within an existing easement, prior to the upcoming intersection improvement.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Cedar Lake Road, County Highway 28, and Monaville Road, County Highway 55, are designated routes on the County highway system; and

WHEREAS, the free flow of traffic along Cedar Lake Road and Monaville Road is beneficial to the safety and welfare to the State of Illinois and the County as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois and Lake County believe it would be beneficial to the safety and welfare of the motoring public if the intersection of Cedar Lake Road at Monaville Road could be improved; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois and Lake County are desirous of entering into an agreement to utilize federal highway funds for the relocation of the gas main (within an existing easement) at the intersection of Cedar Lake Road at Monaville Road prior to the planned intersection improvement setting forth the terms and obligations to each agency, a draft copy of which is attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, federal funds totaling \$262,562, and requiring a 20 percent local share of the total cost, will be reimbursed to Lake County; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by this Lake County Board that the County Board Chair, the County Clerk and the County Engineer of Lake County are authorized and they are directed to execute an agreement and any subsequent amendments thereto, for the relocation of the gas main at the intersection of Cedar Lake Road at Monaville Road designated as Section 12-00153-09-MS.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer shall transmit in writing the final agreement, and any amendments, to be executed by the County Board Chair and the County Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Engineer submit whatever documentation is required by IDOT to obligate the funds and for reimbursement to the Lake County Division of Transportation for expenditures made to relocate the gas main located within an existing easement prior to the improvement of the intersection of Cedar Lake Road at Monaville Road designated as Section 12-00153-09-MS.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this agreement, when executed in its final form, be submitted to the Illinois Department of Transportation for their approval and final processing.
