Ordinance providing for the establishment of an altered speed zone of 35 miles per hour (M.P.H.), currently posted 40 M.P.H on Hainesville Road, County Highway 24, from Illinois Route 120, Belvidere Road to Washington Street, County Highway 45, located in Avon Township, in conformity with Chapter 625 - Section 5/11-604 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes.

### **AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ALTERED SPEED ZONE - COUNTY HIGHWAYS**

**IT IS HEREBY DECLARED** by the Lake County Board, that the basic statutory vehicular speed limits established by Chapter 625 - Section 5/11-604 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes is greater, or less, than is reasonable or safe with respect to the conditions found to exist on the County highway listed in the following Schedule for which the County has maintenance responsibility and which is not under the jurisdiction of the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois.

**BE IT FURTHER DECLARED** that an engineering and traffic investigation has been made upon the County highways listed in the Schedule in accordance with a County Policy for establishing altered speed zones on Township and County highways prepared by the County Engineer and approved by the Illinois Department of Transportation in accordance with Chapter 625 - Section 5/11-604 and Section 5/11-301 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes; and,

**BE IT FURTHER DECLARED** that, by virtue of Section 5/11-604 of the above Chapter, this Board determines and declares that reasonable and safe absolute maximum speed limits upon those County highways described in the Schedule shall be as stated herein.

**BE IT FURTHER DECLARED** that appropriate signs giving notice of the maximum speed limits for the zone or zones of said County highway described in the Schedule shall be erected.

**BE IT FURTHER DECLARED**, that this ordinance shall take effect immediately after the erection of said signs giving notice of the maximum speed limits.
