- The City of Waukegan, through the Waukegan Arts Council, will be hosting a number of art installations created by, or related to, Veterans throughout Waukegan from September to November.
- Through the sponsorship of Lake County's Veteran's Assistance Commission, Lake County has been asked to host an exhibit of art created by Veterans from the Lovell Federal Health Center.
- The County's building use policy limits permitted activities to seven days; any exception to this policy requires the approval of the Finance and Administrative Committee.
- Committee action is requested to allow an exception to the policy to permit this display from September 11, 2015 through November 11, 2015.
