Joint resolution appropriating a supplemental amount of \$35,000 of County Bridge Tax funds for the repair of the bridge deck on westbound Washington Street over the Des Plaines River, approving Change Order Number Three, and designated as Section 14-00067-17-BR.

- Washington Street Westbound at the Des Plaines River Bridge Repair; Change Order Number Three: Supplemental Appropriation.
- This County Board previously approved \$40,000 of County Bridge Tax funds and approved a contract with Sjostrom & Sons, Inc., Rockford, Illinois, for the repair of the bridge deck on westbound Washington Street over the Des Plaines River.
- The Public Works and Transportation Committee and the Finance and Administrative Committee approved Change Order Number Two, in the amount of \$26,935, for additional repair work of the nearby bearing assembly at the east abutment of the westbound bridge under the outer lane of the Washington Street Bridge.
- Change Order Number Three is for the removal/replacement of the concrete under the bearing which is deteriorated, in the amount of \$2,840.
- This resolution appropriates a supplemental amount of \$35,000 of County Bridge Tax funds to cover all Change Orders, which totals \$32,885.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, this Lake County Board, by prior resolution, approved \$40,000 of County Bridge Tax funds and approved a contract with Sjostrom & Sons, Inc., Rockford, Illinois, for the repair of the bridge deck on westbound Washington Street over the Des Plaines River for a maximum cost of \$31,600; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Transportation Committee and the Finance and Administrative Committee approved Change Order Number Two, in the amount of \$26,935, at their meeting of August 26, 2015 for additional repair work of the nearby bearing assembly at the east abutment of the westbound bridge under the outer lane of the Washington Street Bridge; and

WHEREAS, additional repairs are needed for removal/replacement of the concrete under the bearing, in the amount of \$2,840, as detailed in the attached Change Order Number Three; and

WHEREAS, a supplemental appropriation of funds is deemed necessary for the above said additional repair work; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Purchasing Ordinance requires the Public Works and Transportation Committee, and the Finance and Administrative Committee to approve change orders with cumulative totals above 10 percent of the original contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by this Lake County Board, that there is hereby appropriated a supplemental amount of \$35,000 of County Bridge Tax funds for additional repair work of the Washington Street Bridge over the Des Plaines River, approving Change Order Number Three, and designated as Section 14-00067-17-BR.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution being presented to the Lake County Board for approval, the Public Works and Transportation Committee, and Finance and Administrative Committee hereby have approved Change Orders Number Two and Three.
