Resolution requesting an amendment to the Lake County Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Legislative Agenda seeking sponsorship and/ or support of Property Assessment and Tax Reform legislation.

- During its January 8 meeting, there was a Committee consensus to add an item to the County's 2019 Legislative Agenda regarding support for property assessment and tax reform in the State of Illinois.
- In furtherance of this consensus, the Committee asked staff to develop a proposed amendment for its consideration at its next meeting.
- As requested, the draft amendment seeks sponsorship and/ or support from the Lake County legislative delegation for measures that will structurally reform how properties across Illinois are assessed and taxed to maximize equity and fairness resulting in a statewide property assessment system that is uniform and transparent.

**WHEREAS**, the Lake County Fiscal Year 2019 Legislative Agenda was approved by the Lake County Board on November 13, 2018;

**WHEREAS**, the Legislative Agenda may be amended at any point through the Legislative Committee and County Board when time permits; and

**WHEREAS**, the Legislative Committee seeks to amend the 2019 Legislative Agenda to seek legislation that will structurally reform how properties across Illinois are assessed and taxed to maximize equity and fairness.
