Resolution approving the Lake County Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 Health Insurance Plan.

- The Human Resources Department has worked in conjunction with the County's health insurance consultant, Segal Consulting, to present options for the County's FY 2021 Health Insurance Plan.
- Based on this recommendation, the projected increase in costs for FY 2021 is \$2,191,700, for a total projected cost of \$43,321,000, and represents a 6.6 percent increase above the FY 2020 budget.
- The design of the insurance plan has not changed and both the County's and employee's premiums will be determined by the County Board at a future date.

## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, the Human Resources Department worked with the County's health insurance consultant, Segal Consulting, to derive the County's annual healthcare program design and budget; and

**WHEREAS,** based on Segal's review, the projected increase in costs is \$2,191,700, for a total project cost of \$43,321,000, in 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the design of the insurance plan has not changed and changes to the County's and employee's premiums will be determined by the County Board at a future date.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that the County's health plan for Fiscal Year 2021, is hereby approved.
