Joint resolution approving Contract Modification Number One for Agreement Number 17209 to implement an Integrated Case Management System in Lake County, Illinois between Lake County and JTI, Los Angeles, California, and appropriating \$94,000 from the E-Citation Fund for hosted cloud storage.

- The County Board approved an Agreement with JTI to implement an Integrated Case Management System on April 9, 2019.
- An additional negotiated amount of \$94,000 annually was included in the contract at the option of the county for hosted cloud storage.
- The Executive Steering Committee overseeing the implementation of the project has determined that it is in the County's best interest to contract with JTI to provide the hosted cloud storage.
- This resolution authorizes an emergency appropriation of \$94,000 from the E-Citation Fund.

## **RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the County Board approved an Agreement with Journal Technologies, Inc. to implement an Integrated Case Management System on April 9, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, an additional negotiated amount of \$94,000 annually was included in the contract at the option of the county for hosted cloud storage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Executive Steering Committee overseeing the implementation of the project has determined that it is in the County's best interest to contract with JTI to provide the hosted cloud storage.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that \$94,000 be emergency appropriated in the E-Citation Fund for the hosted cloud storage for the Integrated Case Management System.
