Resolution authorizing line-item transfers between various funds for the purpose of transferring previously approved funds in Fiscal Year (FY) 2020.

- Line-item transfers in various funds between line-items in FY 2020 budget are needed to align the budget with correct expense accounts.
- The County Board must approve line-item transfers under certain conditions.
- A listing of the various transfers is attached to the resolution.
- This action does not increase budget authority; it simply transfers previously approved budget authority.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in the administration and implementation of the approved budget, there is occasionally a need to transfer budget authority; and

WHEREAS, these actions are commonly known as "line-item transfers", and must be approved by the County Board under certain circumstances; and

WHEREAS, a listing of line-item transfers of budget has been prepared by the County Administrator's Office, a copy of which is attached hereto and made part hereof, and the Financial and Administrative Committee recommend approval of these actions by the County Board.
