Joint resolution appropriating \$1,115,000 of Motor Fuel Tax funds for the resurfacing of Russell Road, from Illinois Route 131 to Kenosha Road, and designated as Section 13-00077-09-RS.

- Russell Road Resurfacing: Appropriation.
- Russell Road is in need of resurfacing.
- This resurfacing improvement has been identified within the County's pavement management system, and is included in the 2014 highway improvement program.
- Before a project letting can be held, an appropriation of \$1,115,000 of Motor Fuel Tax funds is necessary.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Russell Road, County Highway 19, is a designated route on the County highway system; and

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to the safety and welfare of the motoring public if Russell Road, from Illinois Route 131 to Kenosha Road, could be resurfaced; and

WHEREAS, plans, specifications, and estimates of costs for this improvement have been completed, and this improvement is now ready to proceed to contract letting; and

WHEREAS, before a construction letting can be held, an appropriation of funds is needed.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by this Lake County Board, that there is hereby appropriated \$1,115,000 of Motor Fuel Tax funds for the resurfacing of Russell Road, from Illinois Route 131 to Kenosha Road, and designated as Section 13-00077-09-RS.
