Joint resolution authorizing a contract with Synagro, Baltimore, Maryland, for a biosolids management program for Lake County Public Works in an estimated annual amount of \$597,880.

- There is a need to enter into a contract with a successful vendor to provide a biosolids management program for Lake County Public Works.
- Lake County Public Works oversees the management of the contract which includes site permitting, public relations, preparation of reports to regulatory agencies and the owner, transportation of biosolids, land application of biosolids, landfill disposal of biosolids and all other requirements of a professional biosolids management program.
- An invitation to bid was issued and extended to 12 vendors and one sealed bid was received in the amount of \$597,880.
- Synagro, Baltmore, Maryland, was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder who best meets the needs of the County.
- The contract authorizes a one year contract with two, one year renewals with Synagro, Baltmore, Maryland in the estimated annual amount of \$597,880.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there is a need to enter into a contract with a successful vendor to provide a biosolids management program for Lake County Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the contractor shall provide site permitting, public relations, preparation of reports to regulatory agencies and the owner, transportation of biosolids, land application of biosolids, landfill disposal of biosolids and all other requirements of a professional biosolids management program; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 33.036 of the Lake County Purchasing Ordinance, a bid was called for by publication for Biosolids Management Program for the Lake County Public Works; and

WHEREAS, sealed bids were received from one vendor at the Lake County Administrative Building, Waukegan, Illinois, on May 5, 2016; and

WHEREAS, based on the criteria set forth in the bid; the staff evaluated the bid submitted and determined that the bid submitted by Synagro, Baltimore, Maryland, in the amount of \$597,880 is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for Lake County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that the Purchasing Agent is authorized to enter into a contract with Synagro, for Biosolids Management Program in the estimated amount of \$597,880, charged to account #610-4833299-71660-000-000-000-000-48230, and 610-4843899-71660-000-000-48230.
