## Legislation Text

Resolution authorizing approval of the mandated 2016 revision of the Lake County Emergency Operations Plan.

- Lake County is designated as a "Mandated Emergency Management Agency" by regulation of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA).
- "Mandated Emergency Management Agencies" are required to maintain a comprehensive Emergency
  Operations Plan (EOP) which is updated regularly and reviewed by the IEMA against state standards
  every two years.
- Lake County, through the Emergency Management Agency, has recently completed technical updates to the Lake County Emergency Operations Plan.
- The County Board Chairman is designated by regulation of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency as the official signatory of the County EOP.

## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS,** Lake County, through the Lake County Emergency Management Agency, has updated the Lake County Emergency Operations Plan to be consistent with current state and federal guidance and requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County is required by regulation of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency to submit for review the County Emergency Operations Plan every two years; and

**WHEREAS**, Lake County, by signature of the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, is required by state regulation to accept and approve an appropriate Emergency Operations Plan;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that the acceptance and approval of the 2016 Lake County Emergency Operations Plan by the Chairman is hereby authorized;
