Joint resolution accepting the Health Resources and Services Administration and Illinois Children's Health Foundation grants and authorizing an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$189,661 for fiscal year (FY) 2016.

- The Health Resources and Services Administration awarded \$105,161 in quality improvement funding. These funds will be used for quality-related training, conferences, technology, and supplies for the period September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2017.
- The Illinois Children's Health Foundation awarded \$84,500 for mental health first aid training. These funds will be used for supplies, training, and to offset existing staff costs for the period January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2018.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Lake County Health Department and Community Health Center has received a grant increase delivered by our Behavioral Health and Primary Care Service Areas; and

WHEREAS, these dollars will provide a legitimate increase in services to Lake County with no impact on local taxes; and

WHEREAS, this grant amount totaling \$189,661 has not been previously appropriated, having been awarded after adoption of the Fiscal Year 2016 budget; and

WHEREAS, the proposed appropriation will be fully offset by the above referenced items thereby not requiring the expenditure of local tax revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$189,661 is hereby authorized in the Health Department budget as identified on the listing of expense and revenue budget modifications attached hereto and made part hereof; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the revenue budgets as identified on the attached listing be modified as provided by increased funding from the following:

Health Resources and Services Administration - Quality Improvement, \$105,161;
Illinois Children's Healthcare Foundation - Mental Health First Aid Training, \$84,500.
