Joint resolution accepting the Illinois Department of Public Health grant and authorizing an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$14,792 for the Cities Readiness Initiative Grant.

- The \$14,792 Illinois Department of Public Health grant will help to fund the Cities Readiness Initiative grant by allowing the purchase of open and closed Point of Dispensing (POD) supplies (e.g., supplies to assist with appropriate antibiotic or antiviral dispensing) and Medical Reserve Corps support supplies (e.g., volunteer identification).
- The \$14,792 in additional grant funding has not been previously appropriated because the grant resources were secured after the County's adoption of the FY17 budget.
- The grant award will be for the period July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.

### **RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the Lake County Health Department and Community Health Center has received a grant increase delivered by our Prevention Business Areas; and

**WHEREAS**, these dollars will provide a legitimate increase in services to Lake County with no impact on local taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant amount totaling \$14,792 has not been previously appropriated, having been awarded after adoption of the Fiscal Year 2017 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed appropriation will be fully offset by the above referenced items thereby not requiring the expenditure of local tax revenue.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$14,792 is hereby authorized in the Health Department budget as identified on the listing of expense and revenue budget modifications attached hereto and made part hereof; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the revenue budgets as identified on the attached listing be modified as provided by increased funding from the following:

Illinois Department of Public Health - Cities Readiness Initiative, \$14,792.
