Joint resolution accepting the Lake County grant and authorizing an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$7,500 for the Vector Flood Relief Funds.

- The \$7,500 Lake County grant will be used to fund larvicides for flood-related mosquito control.
- The grant funding was not previously appropriated because the grant resources were secured after the County's adoption of the fiscal year (FY) 2017 budget.
- The grant award will be for the period of July 26, 2017 through September 30, 2017.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Lake County Health Department and Community Health Center has received a grant increase delivered by our Prevention Services Unit; and

WHEREAS, these dollars will provide a legitimate increase in services to Lake County with no impact on local taxes; and

WHEREAS, this grant amount totaling \$7,500 has not been previously appropriated, having been awarded after adoption of the Fiscal Year 2017 budget; and

WHEREAS, the proposed appropriation will be fully offset by the above referenced items thereby not requiring the expenditure of local tax revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$7,500 is hereby authorized in the Health Department budget as identified on the listing of expense and revenue budget modifications attached hereto and made part hereof; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the revenue budgets as identified on the attached listing be modified as provided by increased funding from the following:

Illinois Department of Public Health - Vector Flood Relief Funds, \$7,500.
