Resolution celebrating Illinois Bicentennial.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Sunday, December 3, 2017, marked Illinois' 199th birthday, as Illinois became the 21st state in the union on December 3, 1818; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Bicentennial honors the many ways that Illinois has influenced American history, achievement, culture, innovation, and more; and

WHEREAS, Lake County government joins the State of Illinois, along with cities and counties from across our state, in celebrating and commemorating this significant historical milestone; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Bicentennial Commission has planned several events and activities throughout the year to celebrate our state's 200th birthday, including a yearlong multi-media campaign called "Born, Built and Grown" that honors the tremendous people, places and things that make Illinois strong, kind and beautiful, and

WHEREAS, Lake County encourages residents to be a part of the Bicentennial celebration by visiting the website illinois200.com to view photos, videos and news throughout the year and use the hashtag #IllinoisProud as our state counts down to its 200th birthday on December 3, 2018, and
