Joint resolution authorizing an agreement with ECONOLITE/Traffic Control Corporation, Woodridge, Illinois, for the 2017 Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) PASSAGE Network improvements, appropriating \$145,000 of ¼% Sales Tax for Transportation funds, and designated as Section 17-00999-48-TL.

- The 2017 ITS Passage Network improvements includes five years of software maintenance to the County's Central Traffic Signal System, Centrac.
- 175 traffic signal locations throughout the County will have their controller software upgraded to a newer version.
- The software upgrade will allow for better monitoring functionality of the traffic signal performance and fix known bugs with the current version.
- The upgrade and software maintenance will be provided by ECONOLITE/Traffic Control Corporation, Woodridge, Illinois, who is the vendor and distributor of the traffic signal system software and controllers in Lake County.

### **RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, Lake County, by and through its PASSAGE Program, endeavors to interconnect traffic control signal systems situated throughout Lake County; and

**WHEREAS**, ITS Passage Network 2017 includes the upgrade of traffic signal controller software at 175 locations throughout the County and five years of software maintenance; and

**WHEREAS**, the upgrade and software maintenance will be provided by ECONOLITE/Traffic Control Corporation, Woodridge, Illinois, who is currently responsible for maintaining the traffic signal controllers in Lake County; and

**WHEREAS**, an appropriation of funds is necessary.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by this Lake County Board, that there is hereby appropriated \$145,000 of ¼% Sales Tax for Transportation funds for the 2017 ITS Passage Network, which includes the upgrade of traffic signal controller software at 175 locations throughout the County and five years of software maintenance, and designated as Section 17-00999-48-TL.
