## Legislation Text

Joint resolution accepting the Illinois Department of Public Health grant and authorizing an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$35,000 for the Harm Reduction Community Linkages program.

- Harm Reduction Programs provide individuals with clean needles, which avoids the transfer of diseases.
- The \$35,000 Illinois Department of Public Health grant will be used to expand harm reduction programs, and to offset existing staff salary and benefit costs.
- The \$35,000 in additional grant funding has not been previously appropriated because the grant resources were secured after the County's adoption of the Fiscal Year 2019 budget.
- The grant award will be for the period May 1, 2019 through August 31, 2019.

## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, the Lake County Health Department and Community Health Center has received a grant increase delivered by our Prevention Unit; and

**WHEREAS,** these dollars will provide a legitimate increase in services to Lake County with no impact on local taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant amount totaling \$35,000 has not been previously appropriated, having been awarded after adoption of the Fiscal Year 2019 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed appropriation will be fully offset by the above referenced items thereby not requiring the expenditure of local tax revenue.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$35,000 is hereby authorized in the Health Department budget as identified on the listing of expense and revenue budget modifications attached hereto and made part hereof; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the revenue budgets as identified on the attached listing be modified as provided by increased funding from the following:

Illinois Department of Public Health - Harm Reduction Community Linkages, \$35,000.
