Joint resolution accepting the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) grant and authorizing an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$4,055 for the Environmental Health Beach grant.

- The \$4,055 IDPH grant will be used to offset existing staff salary and fringe benefits.
- The \$4,055 in additional grant funding has not been previously appropriated because the grant resources were secured after the County's adoption of the Fiscal Year 2020 budget.
- The grant award will be for the period July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.

## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS,** the Lake County Health Department and Community Health Center has received a grant increase delivered by our Prevention Unit; and

**WHEREAS,** these dollars will provide a legitimate increase in services to Lake County with no impact on local taxes; and

**WHEREAS,** this grant amount totaling \$4,055 has not been previously appropriated, having been awarded after adoption of the Fiscal Year 2020 budget; and

**WHEREAS,** the proposed appropriation will be fully offset by the above referenced items thereby not requiring the expenditure of local tax revenue.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$4,055 is hereby authorized in the Health Department budget as identified on the listing of expense and revenue budget modifications attached hereto and made part hereof; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the revenue budgets as identified on the attached listing be modified as provided by increased funding from the following:

Illinois Department of Public Health - Environmental Health Beach, \$4,055.
