Joint resolution approving of the Second Amendment to the Program Year 2020 (PY 2020) Annual Action Plan (AAP).

- United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires the submission of an AAP and associated amendments to govern expenditure of federal housing and community development funding for each program year.
- An amendment to an AAP is required to assign program income and/or reallocate prior year funds.
- The proposed Second Amendment to the PY 2020 AAP allocates \$6,041 of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program income and \$49,597 of prior year CDBG funds.
 - Youth Conservation Corps. \$6,041 of program income for affordable housing rehabilitation and resale.
 - City of North Chicago \$49,597 of prior year funds for accessibility improvements at City Hall.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, HUD requires the submission of an AAP and associated amendments to govern the expenditure of federal funding; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to an AAP is required to assign program income and/or reallocate prior year funds; and

WHEREAS, a total of \$6,041of program income have been generated; and

WHEREAS, a total of \$49,597 of prior year funding is available to allocate; and

WHEREAS, the proposed second amendment to the PY 2020 AAP allocates \$6,041 of program income to Youth Conservation Corps. for affordable housing rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the proposed second amendment to the PY 2020 AAP allocates \$49,597 to the City of North Chicago for accessibility improvements to City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Commission (HCDC), at its meeting on October 14, 2020, recommended approval of this amendment to the PY20 AAP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that the second amendment to the PY 2020 AAP is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Lake County Board or her designee is hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents to implement these changes and to complete the amendment process.
