Joint resolution accepting the U.S. Department of Justice grant and authorizing an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$184,383 for the Comprehensive Opioid, Stimulant, and Substance Abuse Site-based Program grant.

- The \$184,383 U.S. Department of Justice grant will be used for existing staff, a new position, supplies, contractuals, and a computer.
- The \$184,383 in additional grant funding has not been previously appropriated because the grant resources were secured after the County's adoption of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 budget.
- The grant award will be for the period October 1, 2020 through September 20, 2023.

## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS,** the Lake County Health Department and Community Health Center has received a grant increase delivered by our Clinical Operations Unit; and

**WHEREAS**, these dollars will provide a legitimate increase in services to Lake County with no impact on local taxes; and

**WHEREAS,** this grant amount totaling \$184,383 has not been previously appropriated, having been awarded after adoption of the Fiscal Year 2021 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed appropriation will be fully offset by the above referenced items thereby not requiring the expenditure of local tax revenue.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$184,383 is hereby authorized in the Health Department budget as identified on the listing of expense and revenue budget modifications attached hereto and made part hereof; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the revenue budgets as identified on the attached listing be modified as provided by increased funding from the following:

U.S. Department of Justice - Comprehensive Opioid, Stimulant, and Substance Abuse Site-based Program, \$184,383.
