## Legislation Text

Joint resolution accepting the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency grant and authorizing an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$18,610 for the Solid Waste Enforcement grant.

- The \$18,610 Illinois Environmental Protection Agency grant will be used to offset existing staff salary and fringe benefits.
- The \$18,610 in additional grant funding has not been previously appropriated because the grant resources were secured after the County's adoption of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 budget.
- The grant award will be for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, the Lake County Health Department and Community Health Center has received a grant increase delivered by our Prevention Unit; and

**WHEREAS**, these dollars will provide a legitimate increase in services to Lake County with no impact on local taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant amount totaling \$18,610 has not been previously appropriated, having been awarded after adoption of the FY 2022 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed appropriation will be fully offset by the above referenced items thereby not requiring the expenditure of local tax revenue.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$18,610 is hereby authorized in the Health Department budget as identified on the listing of expense and revenue budget modifications attached hereto and made part hereof; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the revenue budgets as identified on the attached listing be modified as provided by increased funding from the following:

Illinois Environmental Protection Agency - Solid Waste Enforcement, \$18,610.
