Joint resolution accepting the Illinois Department of Human Services grant and authorizing an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$9,658 for the Psychiatric Medications grant.

- The \$9,658 Illinois Department of Human Services grant will be used for client psychiatric medications and indirect costs.
- The \$9,658 in additional grant funding represents an increase in funding for an existing grant and has not been previously appropriated because the grant resources were secured after the County's adoption of the Fiscal Year 2024 budget.
- The grant award will be for the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.
- If grant funding for the positions and services end, and new funding is not secured, the positions and services will be eliminated.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Lake County Health Department and Community Health Center has received a grant increase delivered by our Clinical Operations Unit; and

WHEREAS, these dollars will provide an increase in services to Lake County with no impact on local taxes; and

WHEREAS, this grant amount totaling \$9,658 in additional grant funding represents an increase in funding for an existing grant and has not been previously appropriated, having been awarded after adoption of the Fiscal Year 2024 budget; and

WHEREAS, the proposed appropriation will be fully offset by the above referenced items thereby not requiring the expenditure of local tax revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that an emergency appropriation in the amount of \$9,658 is hereby authorized in the Health Department budget as identified on the listing of expense and revenue budget modifications attached hereto and made part hereof; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the revenue budgets as identified on the attached listing be modified as provided by increased funding from the following:

Illinois Department of Human Services - Psychiatric Medications, \$9,658.
